LO: To understand the different meanings and spellings of the homophones: their, they're and there.

Lesson:

Today, we are going to be looking at **homophones**.

The word **homo** means the same and the word **phone** means sound. Therefore, **homophone** means 'the **same** sound'.

Their, there and they're all have different definitions and spellings, but they sound exactly the same. Therefore, they are **homophones**.

Task:
