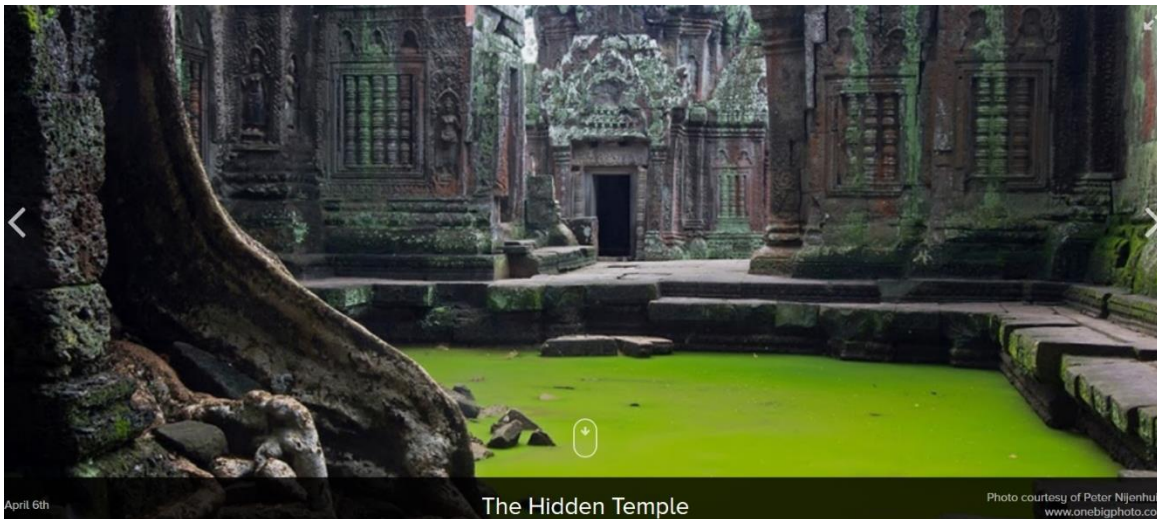
LO: To create the introduction of my story.

In the introduction, you should aim to introduce a character and describe the setting, creating an atmosphere and making it clear what genre you have selected.
