I would like you to create a poster by drawing: £1, £2, 50p, 10p, 20p, 5p, £5, £10, £20 and £50 all around the poster. Spread them out, don't make them too big. (Look at my example on the next page to help).

This poster is going to show us different ways of making different amounts.

Around each coin/ note, I want you to write 3 different ways of making that amount using other coins/notes. For example:



This is why you need to make sure your coins and notes aren't too big. Maybe go one at a time, so draw a coin, write 3 ways then draw another so you know how much space you have. If you need more than one piece of paper, that's fine. 😊

Please try hard to make this poster neat and accurate. I am looking for some perfect examples to go on the website. Colour in your money neatly at the end.
