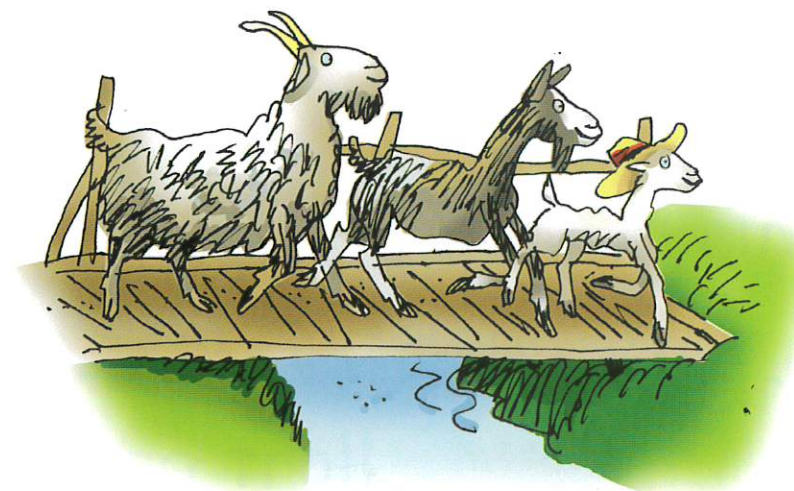

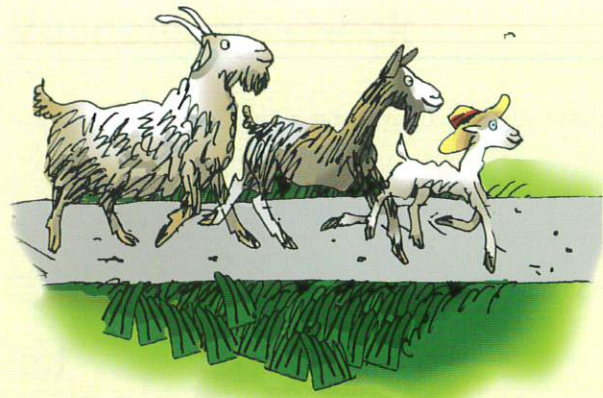
Introduction
