"Yum, yum!" said Flip.

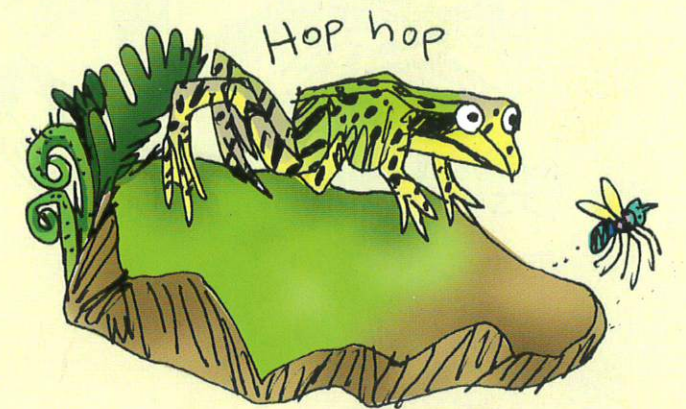
"A big fat bug!"

"Buzz buzz," it said.

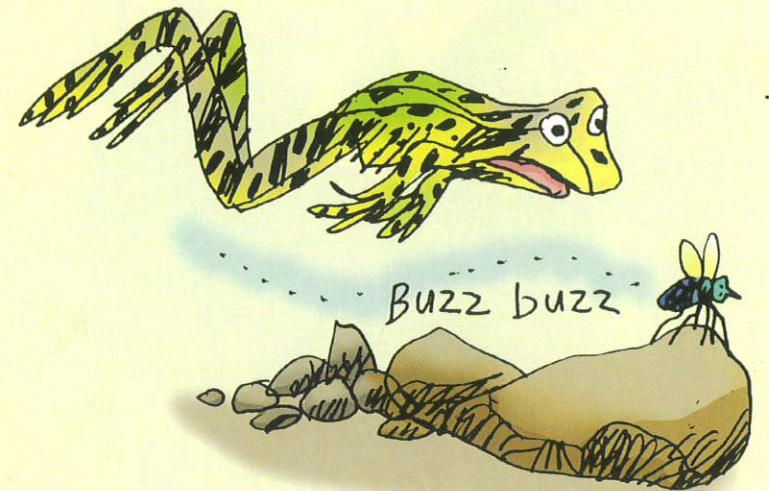
"Stop!" said Flip.

"Stop!" said Flip.



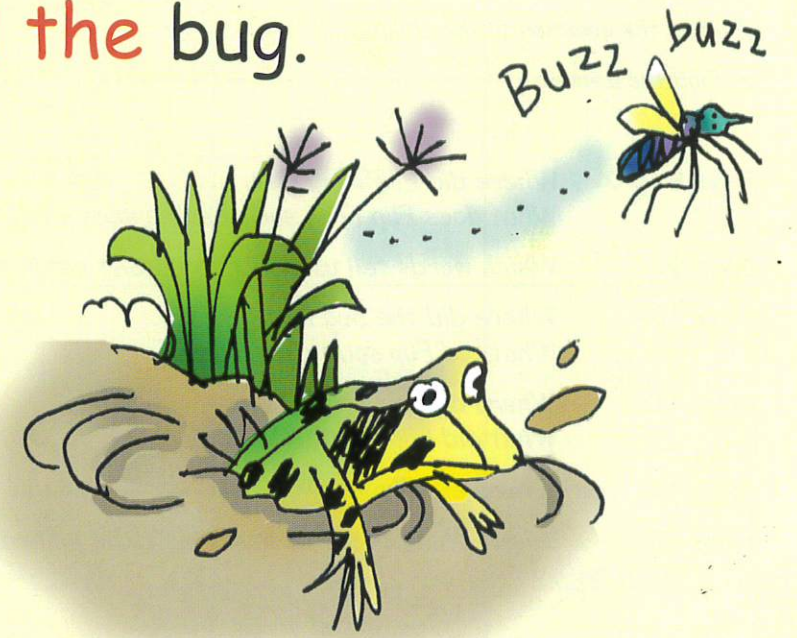
The bug landed on a log ...
