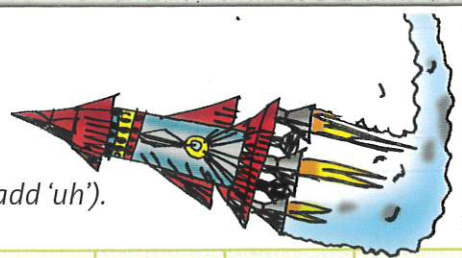


Speed sounds

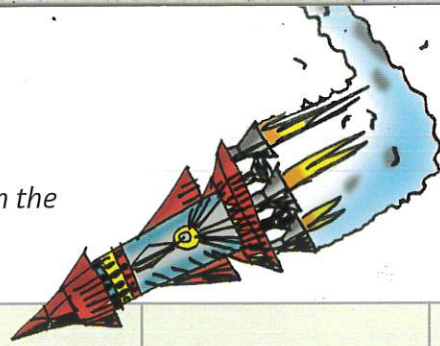
