

Third person recount

Over the next few days, we will be working on retelling the events of the day in third person.

Imagine you are an onlooker and telling the story to someone.

On Monday, you developed a back story by writing a witness statement about the events that happened just before the video begins.

This is the part of the story I would like you to write today.
