

## School's User Agreement for Home/School Internet



The internet is an excellent tool for research and communication. However, its correct use for children within school and at home must be monitored carefully to ensure their safety at all times. The following protocol will ensure that all children at Wistow Parochial Primary School are kept safe at all times. In addition to this agreement, the school will regularly update the children on E-Safety during computing sessions or external speakers.

### **Key Stage 1 and 2: Internet Responsibilities**

In school, we must use the internet responsibly. When we use the internet at home, we must follow the same rules we do in school:

- Act responsibly by following my teachers and my parents instructions when using the internet
- Be safe and follow the SMART internet safety rules at all times
- Use appropriate language communication tools through the internet
- Do not give out any personal information (such as my telephone number, school or address) to anyone I communicate with on the internet
- Do not give out personal information belonging to anyone else, such as their address or telephone number, to anyone I communicate with through the internet
- Act responsibly by telling my teacher if I think that someone else is behaving irresponsibly by breaking the rules
- Check with my teachers or parents before using any websites. In school, use the internet for school work only and with the teacher's permission
- I am responsible for telling my parents or teachers if I see anything inappropriate on the internet. If I accidentally see something that upsets me or that is not appropriate I will switch off the monitor or click on Hector before telling an adult.
- I understand that I must act appropriately when using the school internet at all times
- I understand that if I act inappropriately, my parents will be informed and I will not be allowed to access to the school internet for a set period of time (decided upon by the Head teacher).
