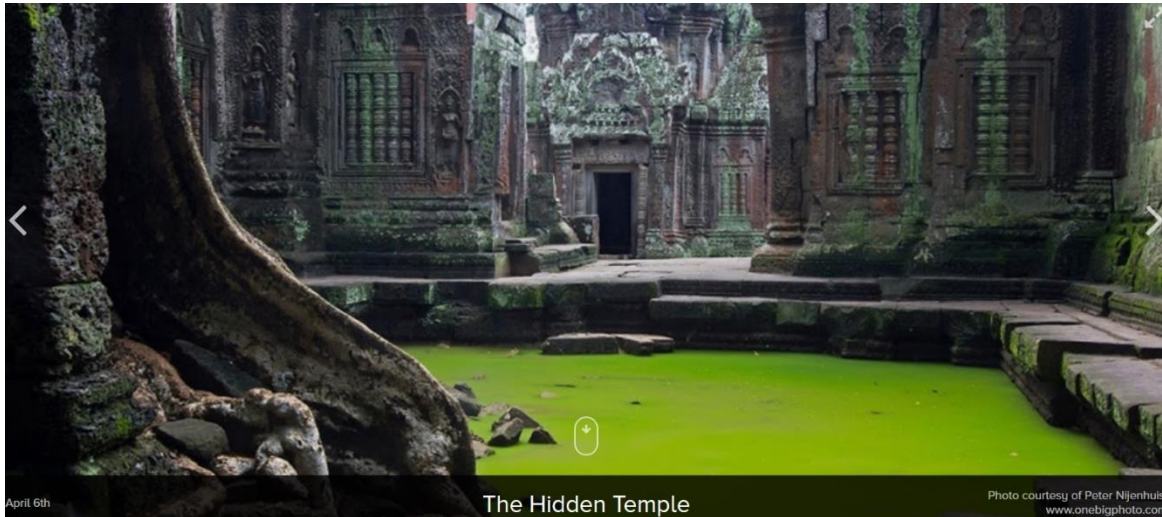


Tuesday 31st March 2020
