LO: To write a biography.

First, I would like you to look back at the poster you made about the features of a biography. They all need to be included in the one you write today.

Remember the biography should be in past tense and formal. You are writing about someone else and all their achievements from the past.

Each paragraph should be about something different, so it is easy to follow and read.

To open your biography, start with an interesting fact or question. Make sure your sentence openers are varied and different to avoid making your writing sound repetitive. You can include a fact box on the top right of the page if you want. Your biography also needs a big, clear title.

I am giving you two lessons to write this because I would like you to produce at least one A4 page of work to a high quality. You can choose to type or write. Include pictures too to make it interesting and to expand on your paragraphs of writing.
