LO: To create a persuasive school prospectus.

Next week, each day you are going to write a section of a persuasive prospectus for Wistow School. Now, this should be easy for you as you are experts on our school and you're all now very persuasive since you've learnt all the skills over the past few weeks.

Today, I would like you to plan your work that you will write next week. Draw 5 bubbles in your book (you'll probably need 2 pages) and write in the middle of each one what that paragraph will be about. Your aim is to persuade parents and children to join our school!

Here are some ideas for what each paragraph could be about:

- The beautiful school uniform
- The fun lessons
- The lovely peace garden, field and play equipment
- The school dinners
- The teachers
- The atmosphere (friendly place that's like a family)
- The after school clubs

You need to plan examples of alliteration, exaggeration, undermining, exclamative sentences, key content to include in each paragraph, titles, subheadings etc.

When you write this next week, I would like to see a clear heading at the top of the prospectus, subheadings above each paragraph, 5 separate paragraphs and lots and lots of pictures and colour. I am looking for complete examples to go on the website so please send me pictures at the end of the week once your prospectus is complete.

Make sure you include everything we have learnt over the past 2 weeks.

Remember what I say - the more detail you plan in, the easier it will be to write next week!
